

The Advocacy Center of Tompkins County (Ithaca, NY) is hiring a Youth Services Victim Advocate who will provides support, advocacy and case management services to sexually abused children, teens, supportive family members and adult survivors of child sexual abuse who receive services through our Child Advocacy Center and through other agency access points. The Advocate works actively and collaboratively with law enforcement, child protective services, prosecution, medical personnel, mental health, school staff and others on behalf of the young person and family and will accompany youth and families to forensic sexual assault exams, pediatric medical exams as well as to court proceedings. They will also provide support services to other agency clients including domestic violence and adult sexual assault survivors.
