

EMERGING TRENDS IN CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE INVESTIGATIONS

About the Course:

John E. The course also examines the identification of potential corroborating witnesses, the joint collection of essential facts and the recognition and recovery of different types of specific corroborating evidence all of which often narrow the focus of the investigation to a specific suspect, while at the same, time anticipating a possible defense.

Lastly, the course identifies the roles and responsibilities of all of the members of the Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) while stressing the importance of information sharing during an investigation.

- Child sexual abuse indicators
- Child abuse seduction sexual activity

- Locating and identifying child molester collections: Child Erotica / Child Pornography / Trophies
- Utilizing consent to search forms vs. search warrants
- The role of technology in the sexual abuse of children and young people
- Addressing the special needs of the technology facilitated “compliant” victim
- Networking with the prosecutor, the medical and the mental health MDT members
- Victim disclosure and talking about the abuse
- Assessing the child sexual abuse victim allegation and corroboration
- Information to be obtained during a victim interview and the corroboration of specific details
- Utilizing the freehand drawing interview process for clarification during a child abuse interview

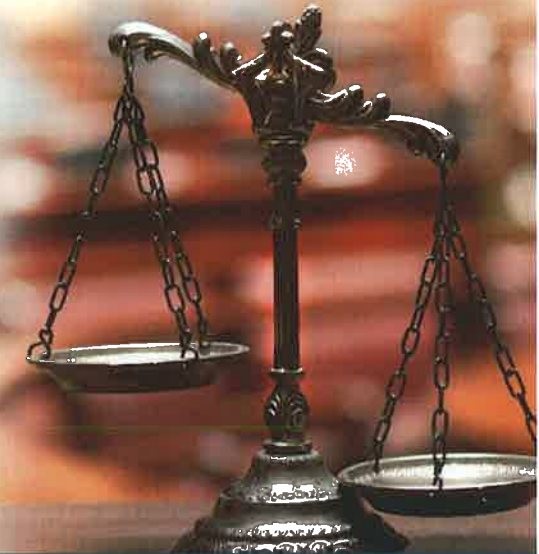

In 2015 and 2018, he returned back to Rome to lecture on child sexual abuse awareness for the clergy and administration in the Vatican – Rome.

As an internationally recognized expert, consultant, author and instructor in child abuse investigation techniques Robert has conducted thousands of child abuse investigation training courses for the U.S. Department of Justice, the F.B.I. and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children in all 50 of the United States and in 22 different countries for INTERPOL.

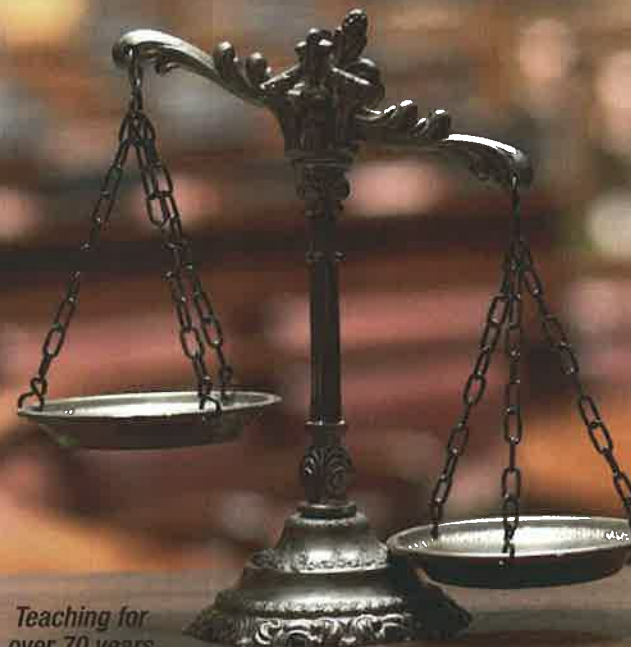
